On or about February 12, 1996, a Notice stating that the board intended to impose a civil penalty of \$200.00 against Dr. Richard Belhumeur (Licensee) was served upon Licensee by certified mail. This notice alleged that licensee treated as a chiropractic physician, and that licensee did not possess an active license as required by ORS 684.020(1). The Notice further granted to licensee an opportunity for hearing, if requested within 21 days of service of the notice. No such request for hearing has been received by the board. The Notice designated the board's file on this matter as the record for purposes of default.

NOW THEREFORE, after consideration of the records and files of the board relating to this matter, the board enters the following Order.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

- Licensee was a licensed chiropractor, practicing in the State of Oregon until August 31, 1995.
- On September 1, 1995, licensee failed to renew his chiropractic license and his license expired, pursuant to ORS 684.090.
- 3. Throughout the month of September 1995 licensee's license was expired.
- 4. On September 8, and 13, 1995 licensee treated as a chiropractic physician.

## ULTIMATE FINDINGS OF FACT Licensee practiced chiropractic while his license was expired. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW Licensee's conduct was a violation of ORS 684.020(1).
