The Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners (hereafter "Board") is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining chiropractic physicians in the State of Oregon. Under the authority of the Board granted in ORS 684.100, the Board is also responsible to regulate unlicensed practice of Chiropractic in the State of Oregon. Tom Burt (hereafter "Respondent"), is not currently licensed by the Board to practice as a chiropractic physician in Oregon.

1.

The OBCE received a complaint on April 5, 1999 concerning unlicensed practice of chiropractic by Tom Burt. After receipt of that complaint, the Board conducted an investigation. Patient 1 received chiropractic adjustments from Mr. Burt on several occasions, and also received three massages. On one occasion he gave her a cervical adjustment which hurt an old neck injury for one week. Mr. Burt worked as a cook in a restaurant in La Pine, Oregon, where he solicited patients, distributed his (chiropractic) business cards and on occasion provided chiropractic adjustments. Mr. Burt represented to Patient 1 and 2 that he was or is licensed as a chiropractor in Montana and California. Witness 1 saw Mr. Burt perform chiropractic adjustments to three or four people in the restaurant while they were seated in chairs. Witness 3 heard Mr. Burt discuss charges with these persons. Mr. Burt charged \$35.00 per adjustment and \$35 per hour for massage therapy. Mr. Burt told Witness 1 that he was licensed in California and that he was on his way back to Ennis, Montana to get his chiropractic license back.

When interviewed by the Board investigator at Mr. Burt's residence in La Pine, Oregon, Mr. Burt confirmed he was "Tom Burt" and his phone number was "536-9591" as listed on his business card for "La Pine Greenhouses." He also confirmed that if anyone called that number they could reach him, Tom Burt. Mr. Burt was then presented with a copy of his other business card which read: "Chirosport Inc., Tom Burt, D.C., Chiropractic Physician, Phone: (541) 536-9591." Mr. Burt thereupon responded to the Board investigator "You're not a cop, you're not law enforcement. I don't have to tell you anything."

3.

On 27 April 1999 the Board voted to issue a Proposed Notice for a civil penalty for unlicensed chiropractic in the state of Oregon.

4.

On April 28, 1999, a copy of the "Notice of Proposed \$10,000 civil penalty for unlicensed practice of chiropractic" was left by the Board investigator at the door of the last known residence of Tom Burt located at 53315 Bridge Drive, La Pine, Oregon, 97739. (Notice is herein attached as Exhibit A) In addition, on April 27, 1999, the Board caused the Notice of Proposed civil penalty to be mailed, certified to Tom Burt at the same address. (Exhibit B attached is a copy of the certified card and envelope with postmark mailed to Tom Burt.) Prior to delivery of the Notice of Proposed civil penalty on April 28, 1999, on or about April 21, 1999, the Board investigator had spoken with Tom Burt at the above address and confirmed that he resided at that location.

5.

The Notice of Proposed Civil Penalty was served by certified mail and gave Tom Burt twenty-one days in which to answer the notice. No answer to the notice was received as of the twenty-one day time period. Nor has any answer been received as of the date of this Final Order by Default. The Notice of Proposed Civil Penalty included in paragraph 9 language that indicated the Board file relevant to this subject automatically became part of the evidentiary record for purposes of default to prove a prima facie case.

Tom Burt, Final Order by Default

The Board finds that the acts and conduct of Licensee described constitutes a violation of ORS 684.015, 684.020 and OAR 811-035-0015(4) for practicing chiropractic without a valid chiropractic license.

7.

It is hereby ordered Tom Burt is found to be in default and that a civil penalty in the amount of \$10,000 is assessed against Tom Burt for unlicensed practice of chiropractic in the state of Oregon pursuant to ORS 684.100(9)(g).

8.

Tom Burt is ordered to pay costs of this disciplinary proceeding, including investigative costs and attorney fees, pursuant to ORS 684.100(9)(g) in the amount to be determined within 30 days.



The Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners (OBCE) is the state agency responsible for licensing and regulating chiropractic in the State of Oregon. An unlicensed person performing chiropractic health care, doing business as "Tom Burt, DC, Chiropractic Physician, is not a licensed chiropractic physician in the State of Oregon The OBCE proposes to impose a civil penalty of \$10,000.00 pursuant to ORS 684.100 (9)(f) for violations of ORS 684.015, 684.020 and OAR 811-035-0015 (14) for practicing chiropractic without a valid State of Oregon chiropractic license.

2.

On or about April 5, 1999, the OBCE received a writtensigned complaint concerning unlicensed practice of chiropractic by Tom Burt. Patient 1 received chiropractic adjustments from Mr. Burt on several occasions, and also received three massages. On one occasion he gave her a cervical adjustment which hurt an old neck injury for one week. Mr. Burt worked as a cook in a restaurant in LaPine, Oregon, where he solicited patients, Tom Burt, Proposed Order for Civil Penalty, Case # 99 - 1009 Page 1

distributed his (chiropractic) business cards and on occasion provided chiropractic adjustments. Mr. Burt represented to Patient 1 and Patient 2 that he was or is licensed as a chiropractor in Montana and California. Witness 1 saw Mr. Burt perform chiropractic adjustments to three or four people in the restaurant while they were seated in chairs. Witness #3 heard Mr. Burt discuss charges with these persons. Mr. Burt charged \$35.00 per adjustment and \$35 per hour for massage therapy. Mr. Burt told Witness 1 that he was licensed in California and that he was on his way back to Ennis, Montana to get his chiropractic license back.

When interviewed by the OBCE investigator at Mr. Burt's current residence in La Pine, Oregon. Mr. Burt confirmed he was "Tom Burt" and his phone number was "536-9591" as listed on his business card for "La Pine Greenhouses." He also confirmed that if anyone called that number they could reach him, Tom Burt. Mr. Burt was then presented with a copy of his other business card which reads: "Chirosport, Inc., Tom Burt, D.C., Chiropractic Physician, Phone: (541) 536-9591." Mr. Burt thereupon responded to the OBCE investigator, "You're note a cop, you're not law enforcement. I don't have to tell you anything."

The conduct described in paragraphs 2 constitutes the practice of chiropractic without a valid chiropractic license and in violation of ORS 684.015, 684.020 and OAR 811-035-0015 (14).

4.

The OBCE proposes to impose a civil penalty of \$10,000.00 for violation of ORS 684.015, 684.020 and OAR 811-035-0015 (14) for practicing chiropractic without a valid chiropractic license.

Pursuant to ORS 684.100 (9) (g), the OBCE proposes to assess the cost of this disciplinary proceeding against Unlicensed person.

6.

Unlicensed person has the right, if Unlicensed person requests, to have a formal contested case hearing before the OBCE or its hearings officer to contest the matter set out above. At the hearing, Unlicensed person may be represented by an attorney and subpoena and cross examine witnesses. That request for hearing must be made in writing to the OBCE, must be received by the OBCE within 21 days from the mailing of this notice (or if not mailed, the date of personal service), and must be accompanied by a written answer to the charges contained in this notice.

7.

The answer shall be made in writing to the OBCE and shall include an admission or denial of each factual matter alleged in this notice, and a short plain statement of each relevant affirmative defense Unlicensed person may have. Except for good cause, factual matters alleged in this notice and not denied in the answer will be considered a waiver of such defense; new matters alleged in the answer (affirmative defenses) shall be presumed to be denied by the agency and evidence shall not be taken on any issue not raised in the notice and answer.

If Unlicensed person fails to request a hearing within 21 days, or fails to appear as scheduled at the hearing, the OBCE may issue a final order by default and impose the above sanctions against Unlicensed person. Unlicensed person's submissions to the OBCE to-date regarding the subject of this disciplinary case and all information in the OBCE's files relevant to the subject of this case automatically become part of the evidentiary record of this disciplinary action upon default for the purpose of proving a prima facie case.
