ORDER

Therefore, pursuant to ORS 183.415(5) and ORS 684.100(9)(e) the OBCE orders:

1. The parties have agreed to enter into this stipulated final order. Applicant agrees to the entering of this final order. Applicant agrees that she is aware of his right to a hearing with her attorney present to contest the charges and hereby waives that right and agrees to entry of this order. The signature of this order also waives any right to appeal. The parties wish to settle and resolve the above matter without further proceedings.
2. Applicant will receive her Certified Chiropractic Assistant License.
3. Applicant's license will be restricted in that for a two year period after issuance, Applicant will be on probation. That probation begins on the effective date of this final order.
4. During the first year of probation, Applicant agrees to undergo urine drug screens with a basic ten panel of drugs specifically tested at random at a frequency of four times for two years. Applicant agrees that a medical review officer, arranged by RSS will further interpret the results of the drug screens (if requested by OBCE) and agrees to, arrange for and pay for all costs by RSS Testing. 5. Applicant agrees to abide by the terms of her federal probation requirements and agrees that the Board shall receive updates about the completion of her probation. Applicant agrees to instruct all professional participating in her probation to promptly respond to the Board regarding her compliance and to immediately report any violations of her probation to the Board.
6. Applicant agrees to abstain from use of all illicit drugs including but not limited to marijuana.
7. Applicant waives all privilege with respect to any drug evaluations, probation reports or urinalysis results in favor of the Board for purposes of determining compliance with this order.
8. Applicant agrees to inform her employer of this final order and the terms required.
9. Failure to complete this final stipulated order with the terms so stated, may result in further discipline, up to and including, revocation.
