The Board of Chiropractic Examiners has received your agreement form.

It is the Board's finding that your record indicates a serious offense. Of particular concern is the Possession of Intent to Distribute Cocaine.

Under the provisions of ORS 684.100 (1)(d) and ORS 670.280, your certification is approved with the condition that you must disclose your felony conviction history to any and all chiropractic physicians with whom you seek employment, and that failure to do so will result, after investigation and due process, in the revocation of your license.
