The Board of Chiropractic Examiners (Board or OBCE) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining chiropractic physicians in the State of Oregon. Esmeralda Salinas (Applicant) is an applicant for licensure as a Certified Chiropractic Assistant (CCA).

On October 12, 2009, the OBCE received applicant's application -n which indicated that she has felony convictions in 2006 for delivery of a controlled substance, child neglect which were later dismissed, and an A misdemeanor conviction for child endangerment. She served 16 months in a woman's correctional facility. Applicant has since successfully completed services and other rehabilitation and education. She is supported in this application by her social worker with the Oregon Department of Human Resources, Child Welfare Program.

Agreement

This matter having come properly before and been considered by the Board, and Licensee having voluntarily stipulated and consented to the issuance and entry of this order by signing below,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- a. Applicant is granted her license to practice as a Certified Chiropractic Assistant.
- b. Applicant's license will have the following condition; she must disclose a copy of this Consent Order to any and all chiropractic physicians with whom she seeks employment.
- c. Applicant will cause a letter to be sent to the OBCE within 14 days of her employment from any current or future chiropractic employers that they have been informed of her disciplinary history. Failure to do so will be considered a violation of this Consent Order.
- d. Failure to abide by the terms of this Consent Order could result, after investigation and a right to a hearing, in a further disciplinary action up to possible revocation.

1 e. By signing this consent order applicant understands that she has been advised of her
2 right to request a hearing on this matter and agrees to waive this right to a hearing or
3 appeal of this matter.

4 f. This is effective on the date it is signed by both parties.
