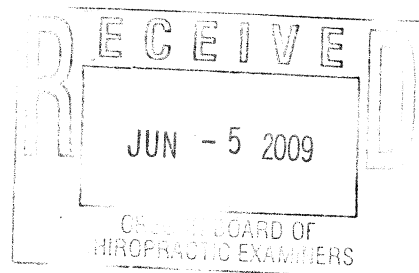

The Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners (hereafter "Board" or "OBCE") is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining chiropractic physicians and certified chiropractic assistants in the State of Oregon. Tatyana Starostenko (hereafter "CCA applicant"), applied for a license as a certified chiropractic assistant in Oregon. The Board proposes to certify the above applicant with conditions on the following basis:

Findings of Fact

1.

In the application dated February 18, 2009, Applicant failed to disclose an arrest for Theft 3 - C Misdemeanor charge. She later explained she had forgotten about this and thought it had been dismissed. The case was filed December 13, 2006 and she plead guilty on January 23, 2007. Court documents indicate she successfully completed community court and the case was dismissed.

Agreement

2.

This matter having come properly before the board and been considered by the Board, and Applicant having voluntarily stipulated and consented to the issuance and entry of this order by signing below;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- a. Applicant is certified as as a Certified Chiropractic Assistant.
- b. Applicant's certficagte will have the following condition; she must disclose a copy of this Consent Order to any and all chiropractic physicians with whom she seeks employment.
- c. Applicant will cause a letter to be sent to the OBCE within 14 days of her employment from any current or future chiropractic employers that they have been informed of her disciplinary history. Failure to do so will be considered a violation of this Consent Order.

- d. Failure to abide by the terms of this Consent Order could result, after investigation and a right to a hearing, in a further disciplinary action up to possible revocation.
- e. By signing this consent order applicant understands that she has been advised of her right to request a hearing on this matter and agrees to waive this right to a hearing or appeal of this matter.
- f. This is effective on the date it is signed by both parties.
