The Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners (hereafter "Board" or "OBCE") is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining chiropractic physicians and certified chiropractic assistants in the State of Oregon. David John Wichman (hereafter "CCA applicant"), applied for a license as a certified chiropractic assistant in Oregon. The Board proposes to grant the certificate of the above applicant with conditions on the following basis:

Findings of Fact

In the application provided on June 20, 2006, Applicant indicated that he was arrested four years prior for an assault in the second degree and plead guilty to the same. Applicant provided information that he met all court obligations and was in compliance with all probation requirements. Investigation of this matter showed that Applicant had plead guilty to an assault 4, misdemeanor on September 2, 2003 in Marion County Court in case number 02C54661.

This matter having come properly before the board and been considered by the Board, and Applicant having voluntarily stipulated and consented to the issuance and entry of this order by signing below;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- a. Applicant is granted his certificate to practice as a Certified Chiropractic Assistant.
- b. Applicant's license will have the following condition; he must disclose this conviction history to any and all chiropractic physicians with who he seeks employment.
- c. Applicant will cause a letter to be sent to the OBCE within 14 days of his employment from any current or future chiropractic employers that they have been informed of his conviction history. Failure to do so will be considered a violation of this Consent Order.
