Once Licensee was aware of the Board Audit, 31 Licensee took 14 additional hours in a good faith effort to respond to the audit, however, those 32 were not accomplished during the time period required. Those 14 hours were completed in 33 34 November 2007. 35 36 3. On January 23, 2008 a Proposed Notice of Civil Penalty was sent to Licensee at 37 her both addresses of record via certified mail. Licensee acknowledged receipt of the notice on 38 or about March 13, 2008 in a telephone conversation with the Board. In the Notice of Proposed 39

Civil Penalty, Licensee was notified to request a hearing within 30 days and given her notice of

contested case rights. Licensee stated she was not going to request a hearing and did not do so

within the 30 day time requirement. Licensee is now in default.

Due to the aforementioned violations, the OBCE proposes to levy a civil penalty in the sum of \$250 for signing a false affidavit and the fine of \$650 (\$50 per hour of course not completed) for failure to complete the CE within the time period required. A total civil penalty of \$900 is levied against Licensee. 5.

Licensee shall pay costs of this disciplinary proceeding, including investigative costs and attorney fees pursuant to ORS 684.100(9)(g).

6.

Licensee has the right, if Licensee requests, to have a formal contested case hearing before the Office of Administrative Hearings to contest the matter set out above. At the hearing, Licensee may be represented by an attorney and subpoena and cross examine witnesses. That request for hearing must be made in writing to the OBCE, must be received by the OBCE within 30 days from the mailing of this notice (or if not mailed, the date of personal service), and must be accompanied by a written answer to the charges contained in this notice.

7.

The answer shall be made in writing to the OBCE and shall include an admission or denial of each factual matter alleged in this notice, and a short plain statement of each relevant affirmative defense Licensee may have. Except for good cause, factual matters alleged in this notice and not denied in the answer will be considered a waiver of such defense; new matters alleged in this answer (affirmative defenses) shall be presumed to be denied by the agency and evidence shall not be taken on any issue not raised in the notice and answer.

If Licensee requests a hearing, before commencement of that hearing, Licensee will be given information on the procedures, rights of representation and other rights of the parties relating to the conduct of the hearing as required under ORS 183.413-415.

If Licensee fails to request a hearing within 30 days, or fails to appear as scheduled at the hearing, the OBCE may issue a final order by default and impose the above sanctions against Licensee. Upon default order of the Board or failure to appear, the contents of the Board's file regarding the subject of this automatically become part of the evidentiary record of this

disciplinary action upon default for the purpose of proving a prima facie case.
