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28 On October 10, 2003, applicant was sent a Notice of Proposed Condition on Licensee and
29 proposed under the provisions of ORS 684.100 (1) (d) and ORS 670.280, that applicant be
30 granted certification with the condition that she must disclose this conviction history to any and
31 all chiropractic physicians with whom he seeks employment and abide by all terms listed in her
32 probation.

37 This matter having come properly before and been considered by the Board, and Licensee
38 having voluntarily stipulated and consented to the issuance and entry of this order by signing
39 below,

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41 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. Applicant will be granted her license to practice as a Certified Chiropractic Assistant.
2. Applicant must disclose her conviction history to any and all chiropractic physicians with whom she seeks employment.
3. Applicant is required to abide by all the conditions of the court order probation, which also prohibits her from accepting employment which involves the handling or distribution of moneys, accounts, checkbooks, or lines of credit without first notifying her prospective employer of the conviction as well as having the written permission of her parole officer.
4. Failure to abide by the terms of this Stipulated Final Order will result, after investigation and due process, in the revocation of her (CCA) license.
5. By signing this stipulation Applicant understands that she has been advised of her right to request a hearing on this matter and agrees to waive this right to a hearing or appeal of this matter.
