Dear Dr. Danis:

The Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners (OBCE) has investigated your involvement with Dr. William F. Henry, N.D., specifically, whether or not you supervised Dr. Henry's practice of naturopathy between September 1, 1991 and August 24, 1992. The OBCE has examined your file and found that you did supervise Dr. Henry in his practice of naturopathy. Therefore, the OBCE has decided to formally reprimand you as follows:

1. The Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners (OBCE) hereby reprimands Paul J. Danis, D.C. (Danis), pursuant to ORS 684.100.
2. Danis is a chiropractor licensed under ORS 684.054 who has practiced at a business known as the Lombard Chiropractic Clinic, 2126 North Lombard Street, Portland, Oregon 97217. Danis did at all times material to this action exercised dominion and control over the business and professional affairs of the clinic, setting its policies as well as implementing them through employees. Danis is not, nor has he ever been, licensed to practice naturopathic medicine under chapter 685 of the Oregon Revised Statutes.
3. Danis has, since 1978, been licensed and has maintained all credentials necessary to practice a healing art as a chiropractic physician in the State of Oregon. With the exception of the above-referenced disciplinary proceeding, Dr. Danis has not been the subject of any prior disciplinary action by the Oregon State Board of Chiropractic Examiners.
4. Danis had an arrangement with Dr. William B. Henry (Henry) to supervise Henry's practice. Henry was licensed to practice naturopathic medicine in the State of Oregon until September 1, 1991, when his license was suspended by the Board of Naturopathic Examiners for having insufficient education to be eligible for a license. Henry has never been licensed to practice chiropractic in the State of Oregon. Danis' supervision

of Henry consisted of Danis being physically present in the examining room at Henry's office when Henry saw patients for diagnosis and treatment. Henry, under Danis' supervision and in Danis' presence, practiced chiropractic and naturopathic medicine. Henry's acts included prescription of drugs and homeopathic remedies under the supervision of Danis.

4. Between September 1, 1991 and August 24, 1992, Danis aided and abetted Henry in the unlicensed practice of a healing art in violation of ORS 684.100(1)(p) in that he attempted to supervise an unlicensed person in the practice of naturopathic and chiropractic medicine.

5. By supervising Henry in the practice of naturopathic medicine, Danis himself was vicariously practicing naturopathic medicine, violating ORS 684.015(3) which prohibits the practice of naturopathy by persons licensed under chapter 684 of the Oregon Revised Statutes.

6. The OBCE hereby reprimands Danis under ORS 684.100(1)(g) and (n), and 684.100(9)(d) for his supervision of Henry.

This Letter of Reprimand will be placed in your file with the OBCE. Any further violations of the above statutes may result in suspension or revocation of your license to practice chiropractic in the state of Oregon.
