Bobby Gene Davis (Davis) and the OBCE enter into this stipulation pursuant to ORS 684.100(9) for the purpose of concluding the Board initiated disciplinary proceeding concerning Davis' alleged practice of homeopathy and fraudulent billing.

Davis admits and stipulates that he has been advised of his right to a hearing in this matter pursuant to ORS 183.415(2)(a).

4.

Having timely requested a contested case hearing, Davis hereby waives such hearing and agrees that this disciplinary proceeding may be concluded by entry of this Stipulation with the following terms and conditions:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS STIPULATED by the parties that,

a. Davis waives any and all of his rights from all sources to any further notices, hearings and judicial review.

- 1 b. Davis agrees that the OBCE has jurisdiction over matters
2 of conduct which violate ORS 684.015(3), ORS
3 684.100(1)(q), and ORS 684.100(1)(a), in that Davis is
4 alleged to have violated the above listed statutes.
- 5 c. Davis is a chiropractor licensed under ORS 684.054.
- 6 d. Davis practiced at a business known as "Dr. B. G. Davis,
7 Chiropractic Physician", 97920 Shopping Center Avenue,
8 Harbor, Oregon 97415.
- 9 e. Davis is not, nor has he ever been licensed to practice
10 naturopathic medicine under chapter 685 of the Oregon
11 Revised Statutes.
- 12 f. Davis' practice included the prescription of homeopathic
13 remedies to his patients. Davis undertook treatment of
14 As part of his
15 treatment of . Davis prescribed homeopathic
16 remedies called "Joint Pain Drops" for
17 Davis chose the homeopathic remedy for and
18 told her to place eight drops under her tongue each
19 morning. Further, Davis admits that he purchased
20 homeopathic remedies, kept them in his clinic and
21 prescribed them occasionally to patients.
- 22 h. Davis' practice of prescribing homeopathic substances,
23 violated ORS 684.015(3) which prohibits the practice
24 naturopathy or the dispensation of drugs by persons
25 licensed under chapter 684 of the Oregon Revised
26 Statutes. ORS 684.010(4).
- 27 i. Davis hereby agrees to suspension of his license to
28 practice chiropractic in the State of Oregon for 60 days
29 for the practice of naturopathy or dispensing
30 homeopathic remedies beginning the day this agreement is
31 entered into. ORS 684.100(1)(q) and 684.100(9)(c).
- 32 g. The OBCE hereby dismisses the allegations of fraudulent
33 billings alleged in the March 17, 1993 Notice of
34 Proposed Suspension.
- 35 j. Davis agrees not contradict any of the facts contained
36 herein.

24 This stipulation is intended to cover the acts and practices
25 described in the March 17, 1993, Notice of Proposed Suspension.
26 This stipulation does not cover actions which are not described

1 herein. Davis expressly waives any objection as to the form of
2 the proceedings and service of documents.

4 If the OBCE finds after a contested case hearing, that Davis
5 has violated any of the terms of this Stipulation, that violation
6 may constitute grounds for revocation of Davis' license.

7 IT IS SO STIPULATED AND ORDERED.
