STIPULATED FINAL ORDER

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6 1.

7 The Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners has jurisdiction
8 over the practice of chiropractic within the state of Oregon and of
9 those persons, including Craig Dawson, who desire to engage in the
10 practice of chiropractic. Dawson agrees that the Board of
11 Chiropractic Examiners has jurisdiction over his license and may
12 discipline him for the underlying factual events and circumstances,
13 if proven, which were the subject of a complaint by a former
14 patient a minor female.

16 The Board and Dawson stipulate and agree that Dawson may be
17 disciplined under the provisions of ORS 684.100(1)(g)(A) in that he
18 engaged in unprofessional or dishonorable conduct. No criminal
19 liability or liability for monetary damages to any person is
20 presumed by entry of this order.

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3.

On December 19, 1990, Dawson entered into a Stipulation with the Board, signed by Christie Joachim, Executive Director, Board of Chiropractic Examiners on January 4, 1991. That Stipulation concluded a disciplinary action involving an indictment in Linn County, Oregon, Case No. 89-123233, entered on July 11, 1990. That stipulation is still in effect. The instant Stipulation, although similar in many terms, is in addition to the previously entered Stipulation.

4.

The Board and Dawson agree that this disciplinary action may be concluded by the entry of this Stipulation on the following terms:

- a. Dawson is suspended from the practice of chiropractic in the State of Oregon for a period of one year, beginning on May 4, 1992;
- b. While holding any license to practice chiropractic within the State of Oregon or until otherwise ordered by the Board, Dawson agrees to continue monthly counseling sessions with a professional counselor acceptable to the Board, and subject to the Board's prior approval, who will provide a yearly report, to the Board, on Dawson's progress, which report will begin in December 1992, all at Dawson's expense;
- c. While holding any license to practice chiropractic in the state of Oregon or until otherwise ordered by the Board, Dawson will submit to yearly polygraph examinations by a professional acceptable to the Board, subject to prior approval by the Board, which polygraph will contain questions approved by the Board or Board's staff in advance, relating to Dawson's compliance with the terms of his probation, the terms of the Stipulation, and particularly directed toward the issues of inappropriate sexual behavior. Said tests to be conducted and reported to the Board entirely at Dawson's expense;
- d. Dawson agrees not to contradict the terms of this Stipulation in any public or private communication.

5.

The terms of this Stipulation consist primarily of terms of probation for Dawson's license. By agreeing to this Stipulation, Dawson's license may be reinstated to active status at the conclusion of the suspension period. If Dawson violates the terms of this Stipulation, the Board may take immediate action against other sanctions available to the Board. Dawson would then be entitled to a hearing as delineated in ORS chapter 684 and the Administrative Procedures Act.
