Stipulations

This matter having come properly before and been considered by the Board, and Licensee having voluntarily stipulated and consented to the issuance and entry of this order by signing below,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Applicant will be granted his license to practice as a Certified Chiropractic Assistant.
2. Applicant must disclose his conviction history to any and all chiropractic physicians with whom he seeks employment, and that failure to do so will result, after investigation and due process, could result in the revocation of his (CCA) license.
3. By signing this stipulation Applicant understands that he has been advised of his right to request a hearing on this matter and agrees to waive this right to a hearing or appeal of this matter.
