Dear Dr. Gilliland,

The Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners reviewed the provisions of our interagency agreement with the Student Assistance Commission and the related statutory requirements at their meeting on May 17, 2001. They determined that when notified of a student loan default by the Commission, that the licensee is immediately placed on probation. This leaves the licensee in practice and on notice. If the licensee has not made sufficient efforts to address this after six months, then the Board of Examiners may consider one of the other two options provided by the law, which is suspension or non-renewal.

As a result of this determination your license to practice chiropractic is hereby placed on probation. You are encouraged to make every effort to have the default status on your student loans removed.
