The Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners (hereafter "Board" or "OBCE") is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining chiropractic physicians and certified chiropractic assistants in the State of Oregon. Seth Goldstein, D.C. (hereafter "Licensee"), is a licensed chiropractic physician in Oregon. The parties agree to resolve this matter as follows:

1.

On May 28, 2003, Licensee signed an affidavit with his renewal stating he had completed 20 hours of continuing education, reading,

"I swear, and affirm that during the 2003-2004 license year, I have completed the required number of continuing education credits (per ORS 684.092 and OAR 811-015-0024). By signing this renewal form, I verify that all information hereon is true and correct."

2.

By telephone call to OBCE staff on October 21, 2004 and by letter dated November 2<sup>nd</sup>, Licensee admits that he did not complete the required continuing education (14 ½ hours short of the required 20 hours) and gave reasons due to injuries sustained in a car accident. However, he signed the CE affidavit prior to sustaining those injuries.

3.

The Board finds that Licensee's conduct as described herein constitutes unprofessional conduct and constitutes violations of ORS 684.092, OAR 811-015-0025, and OAR 811-035-0015 (12).

4.

The Licensee, not requesting a hearing and agreeing to resolve this matter agrees that this disciplinary action may be concluded by entry of this Stipulated Final Order upon the following terms:

1. Licensee stipulates that he has been advised of his right to request a hearing in this matter pursuant to ORS 183.415(2)(a) and to be represented at hearing, pursuant to ORS 183.415(3).
2. Licensee waives his right to a hearing and any appeal of this matter.
3. Licensee agrees to pay a \$250 civil penalty.
4. Licensee agrees to submit the of 14.5 CE hours due within the next 30 days. Licensee agrees to provide all continuing education verification information at the next license renewal in 2005.
5. The Final Order memorializes the entire agreement between Licensee and the Board and supercedes all prior offers, negotiations or settlement discussions.
