The x-rays of are of sub-standard quality relative to their diagnostic value. 14 15 3. The use of sub-standard x-rays is a violation of ORS 16 684.100(1)(g)(A) and (B), and OAR 811-30-020(5), in that the use of 17 sub-standard x-rays is contrary to the recognized standards of 18 practice of the chiropractic profession, and the repeated 19 irradiation of the patient to obtain x-rays of diagnostic quality 20 is a danger to the health and safety of the patient. 21 22 /// 23 /// 24 /// 111 26 -/// 27 ///

28 Page 2 - NOTICE OF SANCTION (GOULART)

Pursuant to ORS 183.413 et seg. and ORS 684.100, the Board proposes to impose the following sanctions.

Goulart must enroll in and successfully complete the next scheduled Radiologic Technology course for limited permit holders. Attendance will be at Goulart's expense and proof of successful completion will be forwarded to the Board within 30 days of the completion of the course.

The Board will randomly review Goulart's x-rays for the three months immediately following his submission of proof of successful completion of the Radiologic Technology course for limited permit holders.

entitled to a hearing as provided by Administrative Procedures Act (ORS ch 183). You may be represented by counsel at the hearing. If you desire a hearing, you must notify the Board in writing that you request a hearing within 21 days of the date of mailing or service of this Notice to you. If a request for a hearing is not received within this 21 day period, your right 20 to a hearing shall be considered waived unless excused for good cause. Upon receipt of your request for a hearing, the Board will notify you of the time and place of the hearing.

If you request a hearing, you will be given information on the procedures, rights of representation and other rights of parties relating to the conduct of the hearing as required under ORS 183.413-415 before commencement of the hearing.

If you fail to request a hearing within 21 days, or you fail to appear at a scheduled hearing, the Board may issue a final order by default imposing the above sanctions against you. Your submissions to the Board to date regarding the subject of this disciplinary case, and all information in the Board files relevant to the subject of this case, automatically become part of the evidentiary record of the case upon default for the purpose of proving a prima facie case.

An answer to this Notice is requested, pursuant to OAR 811-01-010(2)(a) and (b). This answer shall be made in writing to the Board and shall include an admission or denial of each factual matter alleged in this Notice, and a short and plain statement of each relevant affirmative defense you may have. Except for good cause, factual matters alleged in the Notice and not denied in the answer shall be presumed admitted; failure to raise a particular defense in the answer will be considered a waiver of such defense; new matters alleged in the answer (affirmative defenses) shall be presumed to be denied by the agency and evidence shall not be taken on any issue not raised in the Notice and answer.
