STIPULATION

1.

On March 21, 1991, the Board of Chiropractic Examiners (Board) held a meeting wherein it considered the findings of the Peer Review investigation of the complaint filed by alleging that Dr. Graffeo did not keep complete detailed records relative to his diagnostic and therapeutic procedures and that he provided excessive treatment to a patient.

Dr. Graffeo stipulates and agrees that the Board has grounds to impose disciplinary action against him for the reason that he engaged in conduct which violated ORS 684.100(1)(g)(B), OAR 811-15-010(1) and OAR 811-15-010(2)(a).

Pursuant to ORS 183.415(5) and ORS 684.100(9), the Board and Dr. Graffeo wish to compromise and settle this matter by stipulation.

4.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein, the Board and Dr. Graffeo stipulate and agree that:

A. Dr. Graffeo agrees to forward to the Board, on a monthly basis, a list of all new patients. This information is to be provided to the Board for a period of 12 months from the signing of this stipulation. Further, Dr. Graffeo agrees that the Board or an authorized representative of the Board may, with reasonable notice, monitor the chart notes of these patients during the 12 month period described above to ensure compliance with applicable statutes and administrative rules.

B. Dr. Graffeo agrees to enroll in and complete, with a passing score, the next available course in Jurisprudence and Reporting, Module VII, Session 22 of the Diplomate Program in Chiropractic Orthopedics taught by Dr. Richard D. Stonebrink at Western States Chiropractic College. This course is to be in addition to the continuing education required in ORS 684.092 and OAR 811-15-025.

5.

This stipulation is conditioned on Dr. Graffeo's complying with the terms herein. If the Board obtains evidence that Dr. Graffeo has violated the terms of this stipulation, the Board may institute disciplinary action based upon the findings of the Peer Review Committee, in accordance with ORS ch 183, ORS ch 684 and OAR ch 811. If Dr. Graffeo completes the terms of this stipulation, the Board will take no further action based on the conduct described in the Peer Review findings
