RE: LETTER OF ADMONISHMENT

Dear Dr. Holman:

The Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners reviewed the complaint made against you by the Worker's Compensation Division and Wausau Insurance Companies.

Although the Board found no evidence of fraudulent charting, your chart notes were found to be inadequate because they are illegible and do not show objective findings. Therefore, the Board is issuing this letter of admonishment which will be placed in your permanent license file at the Board office.

The Board determined that your actions have violated ORS 684.100 (1)(a), ORS 684.100 (1)(q) and OAR 811-16-005(1) in it is considered "fraud" not to keep complete, detailed and correct records and case histories of the services rendered to each patient.

The practice of "later supplemental" charting has not made your chart notes any easier to read or understand. The Board strongly recommends that you familiarize yourself with the Practice and Utilization Guidelines for NMS and that you particularly note the section on charting.

You have the right to a hearing to contest the Board's actions. If you desire a hearing, please notify the Board, in writing, within 21 days of the date of this letter.
