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STIPULATED FINAL ORDER

Pursuant to ORS 684.100, the above-entitled matter came before the Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners (OBCE) on the complaint of female patient :

Pursuant to ORS 183:415(5), in order to informally dispose of and settle this matter, Michael G. Lang, D.C. (Dr. Lang), and the OBCE by and through its Executive Director, Christie Joachim, make the following statements:

1.

Dr. Lang admits and stipulates that he has been advised of his right to request a hearing in this matter pursuant to ORS 183.415(2)(a) and to be represented at a hearing pursuant to ORS 183.415(3).

2.

Having timely requested a contested case hearing, Dr. Lang hereby waives such hearing and to appellate review under ORS 183.482 by entering into this Stipulated Final Order based upon the terms set forth below.

3.

The OBCE and Dr. Lang stipulate to the following:

AGE 1 - STIPULATED FINAL ORDER (MICHAEL G. LANG, D.C.)

(a) On February 19, 1993, Dr. Lang entered into a physicianpatient relationship with female patient Dr. Lang treated
for an occupational injury which caused hip and back pain.

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- (b) Between February 19, 1993 and October 1994, kept many appointments with Dr. Lang at his office.
- (c) Between February 19, 1993 and October 1994, Dr. Lang entered into a sexual relationship with
- (d) The conduct described above is unprofessional or dishonorable conduct in that it constitutes an inappropriate relationship and inappropriate physical contact with a patient. It represents a practice which constitutes a dangers to the health and safety of patients and the public in violation of ORS 684.100(1)(g)(A) in that it embodies a breach of the ethical duty owed a patient by his or her doctor to act primary for the patients' benefit and health.

4.

The OBCE and Dr. Lang stipulate and agree that this disciplinary action may be concluded by the entry of this Stipulated Final Order on the following terms:

- (a) Dr. Lang hereby admits that he engaged in unprofessional conduct with his patient, by engaging in sexual conduct and contact with
- (b) Another adult must be physically present in the room at all times Dr. Lang treats female patients.
- (c) Dr. Lang agrees to a 30-day suspension from practice, beginning December 1, 1995.
- (d) Dr. Lang must provide to the OBCE proof that Dr. Lang is attending therapy sessions and receiving treatment from Dr. Jeffrey Gray, Ph.D.

That Dr. Gray provide to the OBCE, at Dr. Lang's expense, a report at six-month intervals for the duration of Dr. Gray's treatment of Dr. Lang detailing: .2 3 Dr. Gray' diagnosis of Dr. Lang; ii. Dr. Gray' course of treatment for Dr. Lang; iii. Dr. Lang's response to treatment; 4 Dr. Lang's prognosis; and Dr. Gray' continuing assessment of whether or not 5 v. Dr. Lang's condition is amenable to treatment. б (£) 7 for as long as Dr. Gray, in his professional opinion, deems necessary or advisable.

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- Dr. Lang agrees to continue his treatment with Dr. Gray
- (g) The agreement between Dr. Lang and the OBCE will last three years. At any time in those three years, if Dr. Lang is discharged by Dr. Gray, Dr. Lang may petition the OBCE for modification of the agreement.
- All therapy shall be at the sole cost of Dr. Lang. (h)
- (i)Dr. Lang consents to Dr. Gray contacting the OBCE, if Dr. Gray believes there is a risk to the public by the continued practice of Dr. Lang as chiropractic physician.
- (j) Dr. Lang agrees that this Stipulated Final Order shall remain in force for three years from the date executed, and that during such time Dr. Lang agrees to engage in no inappropriate sexual contact with patients. If at any time within the probationary period, the OBCE proves after contested case hearing that Dr. Lang has engaged in inappropriate contact with patients, he agrees to the use of the incident as a basis for license revocation.
- (k) The OBCE agrees that if, during the probationary period Dr. Lang is discharged from Dr. Gray' care, Dr. Lang may petition the OBCE for modification of this Stipulated Final Order.
