Dear Kristen,

Thank you for your personal appearance before the Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners last week. The Board was impressed with your appearance and commitment to your ongoing recovery. You are lucky to have such good support from Dr. Lanway in this matter.

Enclosed is the Consent Order as the board discussed with you.

Please note the provision that states, "Applicant will undergo urine drug screens with a basic ten panel of drugs specifically tested at random at a frequency of not less than four times a year for one year from the effective date of this order, and up to four times a year for every year licensed as a CA as requested by the OBCE.

The CA applicant must arrange for and pay for all costs related to this testing by a reputable testing service approved by the OBCE and cause that service to provide the results directly to the OBCE."

Our internet search shows two testing labs in Coos Bay, D H Mc Cowan Medical Labs and ADC Testing Centers, Inc. If there is another that could be acceptable as well provided it is a legitimate provider of this service.

Please sign and return the enclosed Consent Order and then we can issue your CA certificate. Feel free to call me if you have any questions.

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12 The Board of Chiropractic Examiners (Board or OBCE) is the state agency responsible
13 for licensing, regulating and disciplining chiropractic physicians in the State of Oregon. Kristen
14 L. Lohman (Applicant) is an applicant for Certified Chiropractic Assistant (CCA).

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18 Applicant has a history of convictions for substance abuse related offenses, tampering
19 with drug records-misdemeanor (2006), possession of controlled substance-felony (March 2007),
20 theft II-misdemeanor (July 2007), possession of controlled substance-felony (2007), possession
21 of stolen vehicle-felony (2007). Applicant served one year in Washington State Women's
22 Correction Facility.

24 While in prison, Applicant started with Alcoholics and Narcotics Anonymous and upon
25 release moved back to Oregon while on probation, began going to AA meetings regularly and
26 plans to continue for the rest of her life. She reports being clean and sober for over three years.

28 Applicant was interviewed in person by the OBCE on March 17, 2011. Applicant
29 reaffirmed her commitment to staying clean and sober. She answered questions about her life and
30 prospects to the Board's satisfaction. In this application, she was supported by the chiropractic
31 physician and clinic staff, where she is currently employed providing office support.

37 This matter having come properly before and been considered by the Board, and Licensee
38 having voluntarily stipulated and consented to the issuance and entry of this order by signing
39 below,

40 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

- 42 a. Applicant is granted her license to practice as a Certified Chiropractic Assistant.
43 b. Applicant's license will have the following condition; she must disclose a copy of this
44 Consent Order, court records, her letter to the OBCE and police reports to any and all
45 chiropractic physicians with whom she seeks employment.

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- 1 c. Applicant will cause a letter to be sent to the OBCE within 14 days of her
- 2 employment from any current or future chiropractic employers that they have been
- 3 informed of her disciplinary history. Failure to do so will be considered a violation of
- 4 this Consent Order.
- 5 d. Applicant will undergo urine drug screens with a basic ten panel of drugs specifically
- 6 tested at random at a frequency of not less than four times a year for two years from
- 7 the effective date of this order and up to four times a year for every year licensed as a
- 8 CA as requested by the OBCE.. CA applicant must arrange for and pay for all costs
- 9 related to this testing by a reputable testing service approved by the OBCE and cause
- 10 that service to provide the results directly to the OBCE.
- 11 e. Failure to abide by the terms of this Consent Order could result, after investigation
- 12 and a right to a hearing, in a further disciplinary action up to possible revocation.
- 13 f. By signing this consent order applicant understands that she has been advised of her
- 14 right to request a hearing on this matter and agrees to waive this right to a hearing or
- 15 appeal of this matter.
- 16 g. This is effective on the date it is signed by both parties.
