THIS STIPULATED FINAL ORDER is entered into between Charles Meece, D.C., and the Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners for the purpose of resolving the suspension and license revocation case brought againt Dr. Meece by the Board in 1989.

THE PARTIES STIPULATE AND AGREE, by their signatures affixed below, that the Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examininers has jurisdiction over Dr. Meece and may enter this Stipulated Final Order in the Board's records concerning Dr. Meece's license.

DR. MEECE AND THE BOARD STIPULATE AND AGREE that the board may revoke, and does hereby revoke, the license to chiropractic of Dr. Meece for the reason that he has violated ORS-684.100(1)(d) in that he has been convicted of a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude, to wit: on November 27, 1991 Dr. Mesce was found guilty of the crime of sexual abuse in the second degree of a female who was being treated by Dr. Meece as a patient in his chiropractic practice within the State of Oregon. This conduct is the subject of an indictment brought by the Grand Jury of Coos County, Oregon, case No. 91CR-2223. The Board further revokes Dr. Meece's license on the basis of ORS 684.100(1)(g)(A) in that he was determined to have engaged in conduct constituting sexual abuse of a patient during treatment, as stated above.
