8 THIS STIPULATED FINAL ORDER is entered into between Charles  
9 Meece, D.C., and the Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners for the  
10 purpose of resolving the suspension and license revocation case  
brought against Dr. Meece by the Board in 1989.

11 THE PARTIES STIPULATE AND AGREE, by their signatures affixed  
12 below, that the Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners has  
13 jurisdiction over Dr. Meece and may enter this Stipulated Final  
14 Order in the Board's records concerning Dr. Meece's license.

15 DR. MEECE AND THE BOARD STIPULATE AND AGREE that the board may  
16 revoke, and does hereby revoke, the license to practice  
17 chiropractic of Dr. Meece for the reason that he has violated ORS  
18 684.100(1)(d) in that he has been convicted of a misdemeanor  
19 involving moral turpitude, to wit: on November 27, 1991 Dr. Meece  
20 was found guilty of the crime of sexual abuse in the second degree  
21 of a female who was being treated by Dr. Meece as a patient in his  
22 chiropractic practice within the State of Oregon. This conduct is  
23 the subject of an indictment brought by the Grand Jury of Coos  
24 County, Oregon, case No. 91CR-2223. The Board further revokes  
25 Dr. Meece's license on the basis of ORS 684.100(1)(g)(A) in that  
26 he was determined to have engaged in conduct constituting sexual  
27 abuse of a patient during treatment, as stated above.

2 DR. MEECE ALSO AGREES AND STIPULATES that this Stipulated  
3 Final Order constitutes a full and final revocation of his license  
4 to practice chiropractic in the State of Oregon and that he further  
5 agrees to not reapply for any license issued under the jurisdiction  
6 of the Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners at any time.

7 FURTHERMORE, DR. MEECE STIPULATES AND AGREES that by entering  
8 into this Stipulated Final Order he waives any rights to appeal the  
9 order or any determination made or any other order which has been  
10 issued by the Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners concerning his  
11 license.

12 DR. MEECE STIPULATES AND AGREES that if he should take any  
13 action which contravenes his agreement herein, that he will pay the  
14 reasonable costs and attorney's fees of the Oregon Board of  
15 Chiropractic Examiners in its defense of the terms and stipulations  
16 contained herein.
