LETTER OF REPRIMAND

Dear Dr. Milanovich:

At its June 18, 1992 meeting the Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners reviewed the complaint filed against you by


In reviewing the chart notes for this patient, the Board found that the notes for 01/07/92, 01/09/92 and 01/13/92 are inadequate in that they contain no subjective complaints or objective findings. Further, the Board found that the notes for 01/15/92, 01/17/92 and 01/21/92 were inadequate in that, although they contained subjective complaints, they did not contain objective findings.

The Board has determined that your actions have violated ORS 684.100(1)(a), ORS 684.100(1)(q) and OAR 811-15-005(1) in that it is considered "fraud" not to keep complete, detailed and correct records and case histories of the services rendered to each patient.

After considering all of the circumstances, the Board decided to issue this Letter of Reprimand which will be placed in your permanent license file at the Board office. You are directed to conform your behavior to the requirements of Oregon law; that is to keep complete, detailed and correct records and case histories of the services rendered to each of your patients.

You have a right to a hearing to contest the Board's actions. If you desire a hearing, please notify the Board, in writing within 21 days of the date of this letter.
