STIPULATION

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7 1.

8 On April 11, 1991, the Board of Chiropractic Examiners
9 (Board) held a meeting wherein it considered the findings of the
10 Peer Review investigation of the complaint filed by

11 alleging that Dr. Muhr made a diagnosis of "thickened bile",
12 inferring a gallbladder problem without any relevant diagnostic
13 tests or related physical examination findings, and that Dr. Muhr
14 is dispensing medication that may be inappropriate for him to
15 dispense.

17 Dr. Muhr stipulates and agrees that the Board has grounds to
18 impose disciplinary action against him for the reason that he
19 engaged in conduct which violated ORS 684.100(1)(g)(B) and OAR 811-
20 15-005(1) in that he prescribed a glandular for gallbladder
21 problems with no reasonable objective findings for such a decision
22 and inferred to the patient that it might correct her neck
23 complaints, and that he kept incomplete and non-detailed chart
24 records by providing no objective findings, subjective complaints
25 or specific locations of applications of treatments.

2 3.

27 Pursuant to ORS 183.415(5) and ORS 684.100(9), the Board and
28 Dr. Muhr wish to compromise and settle this matter by stipulation.

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2 NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and
3 agreements herein, the Board and Dr. Muhr stipulate and agree that:


4 A. Dr. Muhr agrees to forward to the Board, on a monthly
5 basis, a list of all new patients. This information is to be
6 provided to the Board for a period of 12 months from the signing of
7 this stipulation. Further, Dr. Muhr agrees that the Board, or an
8 authorized representative of the Board may, with reasonable notice,
9 monitor the chart notes of these patients during the 12 month
10 period described above to ensure compliance with applicable
11 statutes and administrative rules.

12 B. Dr. Muhr agrees to enroll in and successfully complete
13 with a passing score, the next available course in Jurisprudence
14 and Reporting, Module VII, Session 22 of the Diplomate Program in
15 Chiropractic Orthopedics taught by Dr. Richard Stonebrink at
16 Western States Chiropractic College. This course is to be in
17 addition to the continuing education required in ORS 684.092 and
18 OAR 811-15-025.


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20 This stipulation is conditioned on Dr. Muhr's complying with
21 the terms herein. If the Board obtains evidence that Dr. Muhr has
22 violated the terms of the stipulation, the Board may institute
23 disciplinary action based upon the findings of the Peer Review
24 Committee, in accordance with ORS ch 183, ORS ch 684 and OAR ch
25 811. If Dr. Muhr completes the terms of this stipulation, the Board
26 will take no further action based on the conduct described in the
27 Peer Review findings.
