 7 On July 13, 1990, the Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners
 8 issued a Final Order in a contested case hearing concerning its
 9 licensee, Floyd Harold Nickila, D.C., which stated that he was
 10 guilty of unprofessional or dishonorable conduct as defined in
 11 ORS 684.100(1)(g)(A) in that he repeatedly permitted and required
 12 employees who are not licensed or authorized by Oregon Board of
 13 Radiologic Technology to practice radiologic technology on his
 14 patients. The Board ordered that Nickila be suspended from the
 15 practice of chiropractic for a period of six months from the
 16 effective date of the order and pay a civil penalty of \$1000.

17 2.
 18 On July 14, 1989, Dr. Nickila filed a Petition for Judicial
 19 Review and a Motion to Stay the Enforcement of Agency's Order,
 20 which was subsequently granted.

21 3.
 22 This case proceeded through the appellate process in the
 23 Oregon Court of Appeals and this case was affirmed without opinion
 24 by that court on June 13, 1990.

Pursuant to the Board's previously entered final order and
ORS 676.210,

IT IS NOW FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Nickila begin serving his
six-month suspension on August 13, 1990, and continuing for 180
days thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Nickila immediately pay the
civil penalty sum of \$1000, to be refunded to Nickila if he obtains
a reversal of this case before the Oregon Supreme Court.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
