LETTER OF REPRIMAND

Dear Dr. Nickila:

At its December 16, 1993 meeting, the Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners reviewed the complaint filed against you by

In reviewing the material submitted, the Board found that you provided treatment to 14 year old son without first obtaining parental permission. Further, the Board determined that you provided treatment to son without first taking an adequate history or doing an examination.

The Board determined that the above-described actions violated ORS 684.100(1)(g) and OAR 811-35-005(11).

The Board finds that you be sanctioned with a Letter of Reprimand in your permanent file and pay a penalty.

The Board assesses you a penalty in the amount of \$200. You must pay this amount by January 3, 1994. Make your check payable to the OBCE.

You have twenty-one days to request a hearing to contest the Board's findings. If you decide to contest the findings, you must notify the Board in writing and state whether you wish to contest the penalty or the Letter of Reprimand.
