FINAL ORDER BY DEFAULT

THIS MATTER came before the Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners (OBCE) upon the complaint of patient . a patient of Rena F. Sandler, D.C. (Dr. Sandler). On September 18, 1995, Dr. Sandler was duly served in the manner provided by law with a Notice of Reprimand and Imposition, alleging that she violated ORS 684.100(1)(g)(B) and OAR 811-10-095 by performing a substandard examination and falling below the standard of care, by inadequate recordkeeping, chart notes, assessments and case management of patient Dr. Sandler was given 21 days from the date of service to request a hearing. Dr. Sandler failed to request a hearing within 21 days.

As a consequence of Dr. Sandler's failure to request a hearing, and sufficient evidence contained in Dr. Sandler's file that she did engage in the above conduct, the record supports, and the OBCE finds, that Dr. Sandler be reprimanded for violation of OAR 811-10-095 and ORS 684.100(1)(g)(B), that Dr. Sandler pay the costs for this proceeding, and that Dr. Sandler attend 15 hours of continuing education in excess of her regular annual continuing education.

- 1. Dr. Sandler is hereby formally REPRIMANDED, and that this Final Order be placed in Dr. Sandler's file with the OBCE which automatically becomes a part of the record.
- 2. Dr. Sandler attend an additional 15 hours of continuing education in case history, examination and diagnostic procedures, recordkeeping, prognosis and monitoring patient treatment plans in excess of the regular annual continuing education, and that Dr. Sandler confirm attendance of these hours within 90 days of a final order in this case.
- 3. Dr. Sandler pay the costs of this disciplinary proceeding the amount of \$ 45.00.
- 4. Any further violations of the above statutes may result in suspension or revocation of Dr. Sandler's license to practice chiropractic in the State of Oregon.
