The Board of Chiropractic Examiners determined that you practiced without a license from September 1, 1990 to November 30, 1990.

The Board finds that you be sanctioned with a letter of reprimand in your permanent file and pay a penalty.

The Board assesses you a penalty of \$300. You must pay this amount by February 5, 1991. Make your check payable to the OBCE.

You have twenty-one days to request a hearing to contest the Board's findings. If you decide to contest the findings, you must notify the Board in writing. State whether you wish to contest the penalty or the letter of reprimand.

The Board expects that all licensed professionals will maintain their license and obey the statutes and administrative rules governing chiropractic at all times.

You have shown poor professional judgement in allowing your license to expire. The Board does not condone this behavior and will insert this letter of reprimand into your permanent record.

Your record will now show that you have been sanctioned for failure to renew your license in a timely manner. The Board sincerely hopes that you will not allow this to happen in the future.
