

b) OAR 811-035-0015 (20) Failing to fully cooperate with the Board during the course of an investigation, including but not limited to, waiver of confidentiality privileges, except attorney-client privilege.

c) OAR 811-015-0006 (1) A Chiropractic physician shall make available within a reasonable time to a patient or a third party upon the patient's written request, copies or summaries of medical records and originals or copies of the patient's X-rays.

d) ORS 684.100 (1)(s) ...failing to give reasonable access to the records and files of the physician's patients at any time.

Order

3.

The Board hereby issues a Letter of Reprimand to Licensee and a civil penalty in the sum of \$1,000 to be paid within 30 days this order becomes final.

The Board is also issuing a requirement that Licensee provide the patient records and information requested by Patient 1 within the 14 day time requirement. Failure to abide by this order may result in further discipline, up to and including revocation after appropriate hearing.
