) **DENIAL OF CERTIFICATE**

The Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners (hereafter “Board” or “OBCE”) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining chiropractic physicians and certified chiropractic assistants in the State of Oregon. Erik David Wold (hereafter “Applicant”), applied for a license as a certified chiropractic assistant in Oregon.

Findings of Fact

1.

On June 5, 2016, the Board received Applicant’s application for a certificate to practice as a certified chiropractic assistant in Oregon. On question five of the application where Applicant was asked if he had ever been arrested or charged with a violation, misdemeanor or felony, Applicant responded yes. Applicant also answered yes to question seven that he had been convicted of, pled guilty, or pled nolo contendere to any offense, misdemeanor or felony which could have resulted in imprisonment. Applicant disclosed to the board a 2004 arrest and conviction for providing false information to the police (Linn County Case number 04-030740) and a 2002 fraudulent use of a credit card arrest and conviction. (Tillamook Circuit Court Case number 02-6066).

However, in his application, Applicant failed to disclose a Michigan arrest and conviction from 2000 for assault with a dangerous weapon, Tawas City District Court case M1350025J.

2.

The Board found that Applicant’s arrest/conviction history is concerning, specifically, Applicant’s deception as to the Michigan arrest and conviction.

3.

On September 27, 2016, Applicant was served with a Proposed Notice for Denial of Chiropractic Assistant Certificate. In that Notice, Applicant was provided that a hearing was required to be requested within 60 days. Applicant was also notified that if a hearing was not requested a notice of default would be issued based on the Board record. Applicant did not request a hearing in a timely manner.

Conclusions of Law

4.

The Board finds that the acts and conduct of Applicant in his application, and responses to such, are cause to refuse to grant a certificate to Applicant. The arrest and conviction history as noted above, is a violation of **OAR 811-010-0110(15)(a)(b) (m) and (16)** unprofessional or dishonorable conduct and conviction of a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude or a felony. In addition the deception in not providing all information to the Board. The Board also feels pursuant to ORS 670.280(3) the arrest history and convictions are substantially related to the fitness and ability of the applicant to engage in the activity for which the license is required.

ORDER

5.

The Board finds Applicant is in default to request a hearing. Applicant's request to be certified as a Chiropractic Assistant is hereby denied.

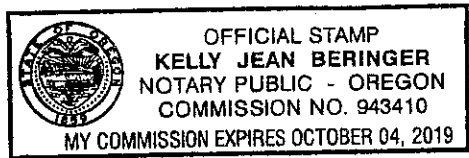
